An Update from the **Moving Forward Committee**

The Moving Forward Committee met on Sunday, April 23. We discussed the fact that 264 Holston churches chose to disaffiliate at a special session of the Annual Conference on Saturday, April 22. While this is a significant number of churches, 79% of conference membership remains. The Moving Forward team heard from individuals who attended this meeting and was able to ask questions about their experience.

At this point, the Moving Forward team has affirmed our decision to wait until the General Conference meeting in Spring 2024 to make any decision related to disaffiliation. We continue to be in touch with District and Conference leadership about disaffiliation and how it would impact our congregation. As we await a decision from General Conference, we continue to listen and stand ready to help in any way possible. We ask three things:

Continue to **PRAY** for God to lead Holston Conference and Keith Memorial UMC through these challenging days. While it is discouraging to hear news regarding the split of the United Methodist Church, please don't react in fear. Hold onto faith that God is leading us in new ways.

TALK with Pastor Melissa or any member of the Moving Forward Committee about questions you may have. We are ready and willing to speak to any individual or small group about the issue of disaffiliation. Please reach out for clarification instead of sharing information that may be false.

ATTEND a congregational meeting on Sunday, June 11 at 6:00pm in the Gathering. This will be after the Holston Annual Conference meets. We will look at the future of Keith Church's ministry and give updates on the Conference and the Moving Forward Committee. No decisions will be made at this meeting, but we will try to answer any questions you may have.
