Guidelines for Photographers & Videographers

You have been asked to photograph/video a wedding at Keith Memorial United Methodist Church. We look forward to working with you. Professional videographers, outside of Keith Church, may be used for wedding services in the sanctuary and the Gathering.

- In the sanctuary, video equipment is allowed in the balcony or in the choir loft pit area (unmanned stationary camera);
- Pictures and videos may be taken at any time during the wedding ceremony as long as the sacredness of the ceremony is respected.
- ♦ We ask that the photographer be as unobtrusive as possible during the ceremony. Flash photography is not allowed at any point during the wedding ceremony by either the photographer or the wedding guests.
- Photographers and videographers are not permitted to stand on any furniture or fixtures in the church.
 Please bring your own step stool.
- If you have any questions, please ask. It is better to clarify before the wedding than cause any disturbance during the ceremony.
- Drone photography is not permitted within the church.

- ♦ Seasonal decorations placed in any location within Keith Church by the Altar Guild and related organizations may not be moved or removed.
- ◆ Rice, birdseed, confetti or anything else may not be thrown either inside or outside the facilities, with the exception of the flower petals tossed by the flower girl(s).
